Please contact Jude McLane (mclane@oq.rutgers.edu), who will work with the nominator to secure the necessary grid to be included with this nomination form. If teaching grid is not applicable, please provide other means of evaluating teaching (e.g., student feedback, peer observation, teaching statement/portfolio, sample of syllabi/lectures, awards, etc.).
- d. A condensed curriculum vitae, no more than 5 pages in length (which must include masters/doctoral degree supervision, with dates, and all internal and external grants, fellowships, and/or prizes related to teaching and research, including funding sources and amount of awards).
- e. Other relevant brief statements or evidence of excellence or distinction.
