### Clement A. Price Human Dignity Awards 2018-2019 Invitation for Nomination and Guidelines

The Rutgers University Clement A. Price Human Dignity Award, is administered by the *Committee to Advance Our Common Purposes* (CACP), a program reporting to the Associate Vice President for Strategic Initiatives under the auspices of the Office of the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs. The award honors individuals and groups who have demonstrated exceptional achievement and a commitment to promoting and practicing diversity, inclusion, and equity at Rutgers and in the broader community. This award is open to all university students, faculty, staff, departments, centers, institutes and units from Camden, Newark, New Brunswick/Piscataway and RBHS. Non-Rutgers individuals and groups whose projects have ties to the university and have demonstrated the same commitment to diversity are also eligible. Honorees will receive a plaque, citation, and a monetary gift.

Please Save-the-Date - Monday, April 15, 2019, 12:00 - 2:00 pm, in the College Avenue Student Center for a university wide reception to recognize and celebrate the 2018-2019 honorees.

#### Criteria for prospective recipients:

- History of forging intercultural cooperation and collaborations, especially among groups that ordinarily have not worked together
- Demonstrated a sense of social responsibility and is respected as a role model
- Reducing prejudice and promoting respect for diversity, inclusion, equity and access
- Creating an inclusive community and climate of civility among students, faculty, and staff
- A history of developing sustainable projects

1. **Nomination and Nominee Abstract Form:** The nominee abstract should be a brief overview, no more than 125 words, describing the reasons you have nominated this person, group, or organization for the award. Language from the “Abstract” will appear on the award citation as well as in the printed program.
2. **Nomination Narrative:** Narrative detailing the nominee’s adherence to criteria. In no more than three pages, please explain how the nominee exemplifies the criteria. Provide details of the nominee’s programs, services, character, and outstanding accomplishments. If a nominee’s diversity efforts are job-related, then the nomination must exemplify how the nominee’s diversity, inclusion and equity related achievements go beyond the scope of assigned duties. No self-nominations are permitted.

**Optional support letters for nominees are welcomed but not required.**
